Geographic area (GA): Boundary, Bonner, Kootenai, Shoshone, Benewah, Latah, Lewis, Nezperce, Idaho Counties

Funds available in GA: EQIP \$5.8 Million, CSP (state fund pool) \$10.6 million

Categories that Team 1 will be able to compete in: Joint Chief (last year) National Air Quality Initiative, Regenerative ag pilot program, Beginning farmer, Social disadvantage, LWG

- Joint Chief: must fall within the area of the highway 95 fuels corridor
- National Air Quality Initiative: Must address area quality particulate emissions. (forestry practices address this
- Regenerative Ag Pilot Program:
 - Must agree to implement CEMA 216, soil health testing, in first and last year of contract, CEMA 216 must be completed by qualified individual
 - Must assess whole farm
 - Must be planning or implementing to NRCS standard a primary Soil health practice
 - Must be meeting at the end of the contract soil and water resource concerns
- Beginning farmer: Must quality as beginning farmer
- Social disadvantage: must met the criteria for SDFR
- LWG: there are 5 categories that make up this, Cropland, Forestland, Grazing land, High tunnels, AFO
 - We are working to take all 4 LWG's priorities to ensure that ranking will compare applications across the area fairly
